

The Edwards' schedule is a six-month program, designed to allow any Webelos scout to achieve the **Arrow of Light** award within a six-month period and the **Twentier** award in one year. Badges are paired to allow variety between the more active badges and the more passive, "intellectual" ones.

Month	Badges	Rationale	notes
September	Readyman Handyman	We always cover Readyman before a hike, for obvious reasons. The hike is scheduled for October due to weather. We cover the bicycle requirements of Handyman in preparation for the bike hike next month.	First-aid w/ Scouts (this counts as a boy-scout troop meeting for Arrow of Light requirement #4, this also helps the Boy Scouts earn their First-Aid merit badge.)
October	Outdoorsman Artist	Have the boys draw their outdoor picture while on the hike. They can even gather natural materials to make a frame (craftsman project).	Bike hike
November	Craftsman Family Member	We make Christmas gifts for family members as Craftsman projects. With family visiting for holidays, this is also a good time for Family Member.	
December	Showman Communicator	Because we go caroling with our pack, it is an obvious time for Showman and thank-you notes to family make this a great time for Communicator.	Caroling with Pack
January	Citizen Athlete	Many use January to start new fitness regimens. Regular exercise is part of the athlete badge.	
February	Fitness Engineer		All-Scout Banquet (this activity takes the place of a troop meeting so this can count as a Scout troop meeting for Arrow of Light requirement #4)
March	Readyman Geologist	We always cover Readyman before a hike, for obvious reasons. The hike is scheduled for March due to weather. Many of the Geologist requirements can also be covered on the hike.	Hike (with Boy Scouts) (this counts as an outdoor oriented activity for Arrow of Light requirement #4)
April	Outdoorsman Scholar	We are proposing that our district sponsor a Webeloree in April, during which the boys accomplish their Outdoorsman. The end of the school year is a good time for Scholar.	(Webeloree)
May	Citizen Scientist	Performing the requirements for Citizen before summer prepares the boys to participate more fully in the patriotic events of June and July.	
June	Forester Aquanaut	Outdoor pools, even unheated ones, become available for Aquanaut this month. Camping is also popular this month for Forester.	
July	Naturalist Traveler	Traveler is an obvious choice for summer vacations. Also, many families camp and/or visit nature centers while on vacation for Naturalist.	Ward Campout (this activity takes the place of a troop meeting so this can count as an outdoor oriented activity for Arrow of Light requirement #4)
August	Fitness Sportsman	As school starts many boys enroll in fall sports teams.
